100 Club Nomination

On July 21, 2020, the Conroe Fire Department responded to a working structure fire with a report of victims trapped at 407 Wagers Street. E3 arrived to find fire on the east side of the residence in the carport and A/B side interior. The E3 crew was directed to a front window by a neighbor who had heard a woman yelling for help and had attempted to get inside. The neighbor had broken the window but could not get into the residence because of the burglar bars. E3 firefighter Blaha stretched an attack line to the carport and knocked down the exterior fire while Lt. Robinson and Firefighter Hammond attempted to cut the burglar bars at the window with a K12 saw. They cut one side of the bars and the saw stalled due to heavy smoke conditions. Firefighter Blaha rejoined Lt. Robinson and Firefighter Hammond at the front door. They used a haligan to force the burglar bars and the front door. The door would not open very far due to the personal belongings, boxes, and other materials stored in the hallway. They entered the residence and encountered fire in the A/B side of the house and heavy smoke throughout. Firefighter Blaha used the hand line to control the fire so Lt. Robinson and Firefighter Hammond could make a right-hand search of the residence. Lt. Robinson entered a bedroom in the back, looking for a second victim as originally reported, and Firefighter Hammond entered an adjacent bedroom in the front where a woman was reported to have been yelling for help. Firefighter Hammond found the resident, Melody Herring, unconscious on the floor at the front window in heavy smoke conditions. There was no one else in the residence.

While E3 was searching the residence, E2 arrived and began working to remove the burglar bars from the front window. E1, E4, L1 and E5 arrived to continue fire suppression. Due to the number of items stored in the home, E3 chose to try again to remove the burglar bars from front window. With the efforts of E2 and E3 the bars were removed. Firefighter Hammond lifted Melody Herring up into the window where the E2 could assist in getting her out and to the ground. E2 Lt. Blaine Pyles and Firefighter Sean Semora carried the patient away from the residence and to waiting MCHD EMS crew where they began rescue breathing for her.

The patient was transported to the burn unit at Hermann Hospital in Houston. She remained there for treatment of burns to her legs and smoke inhalation. She was discharged in September and now lives with relatives.
